NEWS FROM OUR PARTNERS!

North Tahoe-Truckee Homeless Services (NTTHS) started as the Emergency Warming Center in 2015. Since 2020, NTTHS has expanded into 4 programs: Emergency Warming Center, Emergency Respite Day Center, Outreach Program, and Housing Program. **Emergency Warming Center:** NTTHS operates a seasonal shelter from November to April on weather-triggered evenings (15 degrees or 1 foot of snow or more). **Emergency Respite Day Center:** NTTHS operates a year-round day center Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday where community members who are unhoused and low-income can come for lunch, showers, laundry, clothing closet, and case management. **Outreach Program:** NTTHS travels around Truckee and North Lake to outreach and engage with unhoused community members. **Housing Program:** NTTHS supports unhoused community members with first month rent and security deposit.

NTTHS accepts donations of sleeping bags, backpacks, tents, and non-perishable food year-round. NTTHS is always looking for volunteers to staff our kitchen: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 1pm-5pm and seasonally Nov-April: 7am-9am and 6pm-8pm. NTTHS is located on 10079 Church Street in Truckee.
