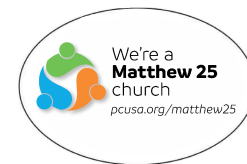

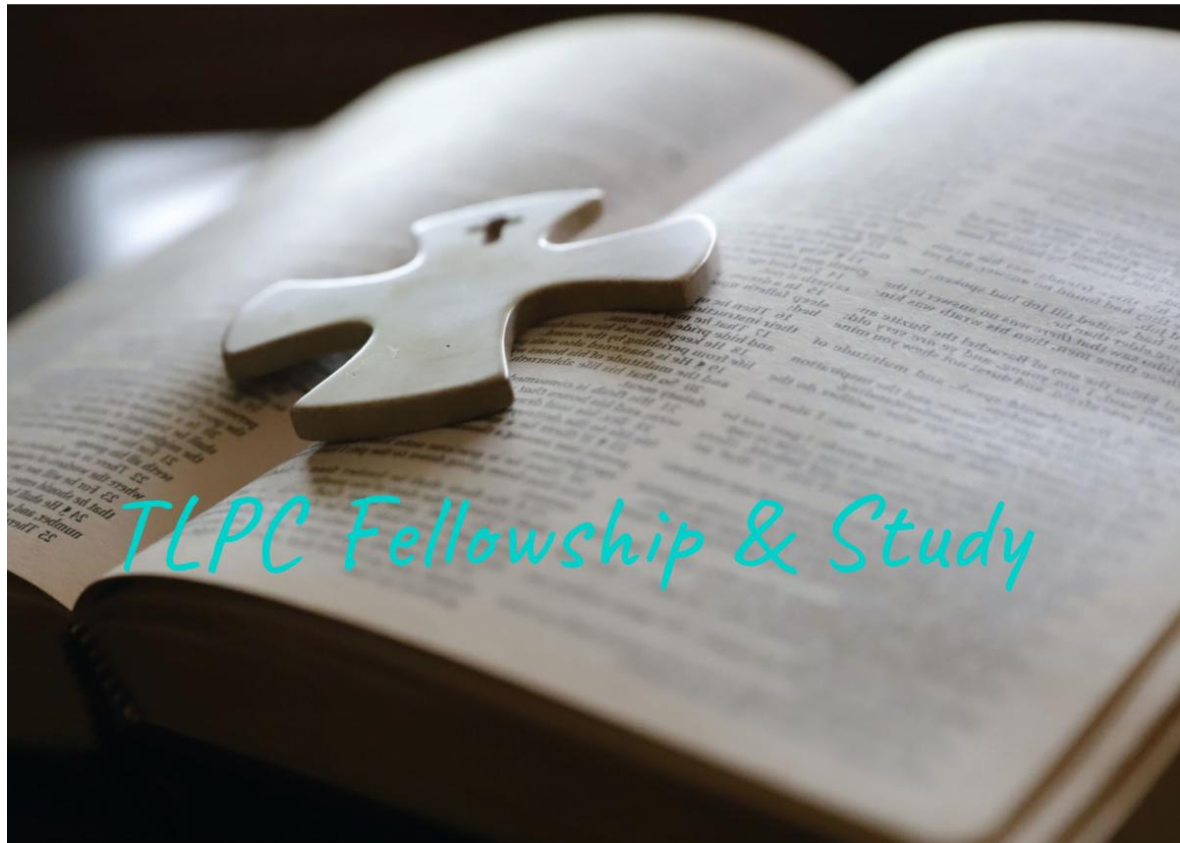
Last Sunday I was at the Assembly for the Sierra Pacific Synod of the ELCA. We elected a new bishop, Rev. Jeff Johnson.

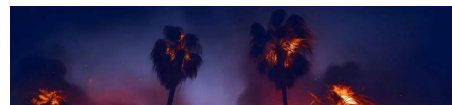
